5. <u>Updates of the Fund</u>

We are pleased to report that we had awarded student grants to 122 students as at 31 March 2023. For details, please refer to the Report and Financial Statements for the year ending 31 March 2023. Briefly, a total of HK\$15.4 million have been donated to the Fund and grants (including funds reserved but not paid out to the successful applicants) totalling HK12.0 million had been disbursed. While we still have a balance of around HK\$3.3 million, which is sufficient to award grants to another 20 students in the coming years, the Trustees and the Chamber will continue to work agressively to solicite more donations for this very worthy cause. Meanwhile, we would like to thank the donors that had supported us over the past years.

6. Nurturing Next Generation Malaysians

MAYCHAM through its Students Trust Fund has provided financial assistance to Malaysian students in Hong Kong & Macau since 2016. We are aware that there are many successful Malaysians in Hong Kong & Macau in many industries and many of them are very generous and happy to contribute back to the society and more so, to our fellow Malaysians.

While our programs started out to support Malaysian students in Hong Kong & Macau , it has since evolved to include and benefit the children of our members too. Through the LinkedIn Group in the name of MAYCHAM and Alumni/Students from HK & Macau Universities which was set up on September 2020, we manage to link many of the students and alumni as well as many MAYCHAM members, who are from different professions into same Group, for all of us to keep in touch, network and get support when needed.

Although most of our activities were conducted through webinar due to COVID restrictions, we were able to meet up with some of the student recipients lately. Many thanks to all those who volunteered their personal time to speak/meet up with the student recipients. My sincere gratitude to all our mentors (not limited to Liow Zen Pin, Jo An Yee, Ming Wong, Marcos Chow & Sylvia Chuah) and also, Gina Wong and Eeswary for organizing the events for benefit of all Malaysian students.
